Sandra Calloway Memorial Scholarship

Two scholarships will be awarded to seniors from local or surrounding school districts of the Texarkana metro area.

Guidelines for Scholarship:

1. Candidates for this award shall be (a) graduating seniors with leadership qualities and exemplary character, (b) students with college commitment and plan to **Major in Education**, (c) students in the top 50% of the graduating class, (d) students in actual need of financial assistance to continue their education.
2. Completed applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
3. Applications will be sent to the Counselor's Office of each high school. Applications may also be received from members of the Twin City Black History Association.
4. Candidates **must submit:** a completed application, a copy of his/her transcript, photograph, and three letters of recommendation. One letter will need to come from a principal, teacher, or counselor. The completed application will be sent to the following address: **Anita L. Pickett ~ 1601 Beech Street ~ Texarkana, AR 71854 by April 6, 2026.**
5. The scholarship committee will send a notice to the counselor of the selected candidates giving the amount and instructions on securing the scholarship. The scholarship recipients must provide proof of enrollment from the college admissions office by October 12, 2026. Once the scholarship committee receives this information a check will be sent directly to the scholarship recipient.
6. This scholarship will be awarded to the recipient during the Senior Awards program at the high school where the recipient attends by a member of the Twin City Black History Association.
